The Criminal Justice Studies Graduate Certificate includes 12 semester hours of graduate coursework for students who want to increase their knowledge and develop competencies in the areas of criminal causality, criminal law, police management and/or correctional settings. The courses are designed in such a way as to cater to the working professional. The courses are offered completely online. Each course is Five (5) weeks in length.
