COB 578 - Statistical Methods

Hours: 3

A course dealing with the study and applications of sampling, estimation, hypothesis testing, analysis of variance, correlation, regression analysis, time series decision theory and nonparametric statistical methods.

COB 595 - Research Methods

Hours: 3

This course emphasizes research processes and methods as applied to business disciplines. The course engages students in defining research problems and in collecting, analyzing, and interpreting data, along with evaluating relevant business research literature. Students gain an understanding of qualitative and quantitative techniques, including statistics, regression, optimization, and other applied analytic methods, and learn to interpret and present research results.
